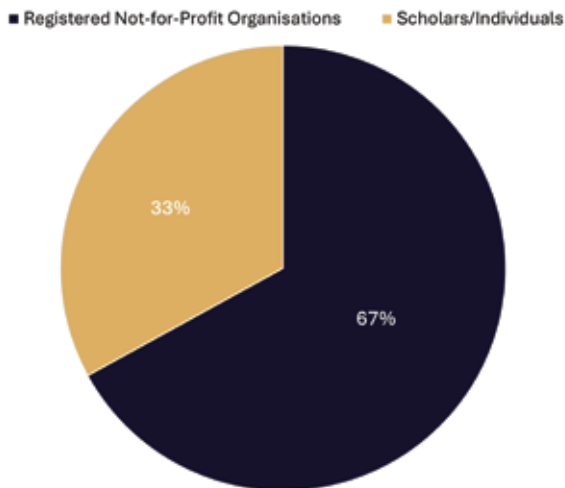


# MAKING A DIFFERENCE THROUGH COMMUNITY INVESTMENT

Contributing to societal welfare and fostering positive change are central commitments of OSK Holdings Berhad (“OSK”). Through our philanthropic arm, OSK Foundation, we actively invest in community development initiatives, advancing the social and economic well-being of the communities in which we operate. Our efforts are focused on creating a meaningful impact by providing resources and opportunities in three key areas: Education, Community Development, and the Environment.

In FY2023, OSK Foundation contributed RM2.1 million to various initiatives, positively impacting the lives of 10,846 individuals. Of this, RM1.4 million, or 67.0% of the funds, was channelled to registered not-for-profit organisations.

## OSK’s Good Cause initiative

In July 2024, we returned to Kampung Paya Mendoi in Kuala Krau, Pahang, to build our second house and expand the community hall to include a library. This initiative, jointly organised by OSK Group and OSK Foundation, completed over a month and a half, aimed to uplift a family in need and enrich the lives of local residents, supported by the Orang Asli Association of Peninsular Malaysia.

The new single-storey house, constructed using pre-cast wall panels from our Industrial Building System Division, was built for Mr. Syamli Jahidin and his family of four. Previously, they had been living with relatives because their old house was no longer habitable. On 20th and 21st July 2024, a total of 40 employee volunteers spent the weekend finalising the house's construction, including tasks such as wall rendering, painting, door installation, landscaping, and cleaning.

Additionally, we expanded the community hall to establish a library, furnishing it with tables and chairs. Stocked with books collected from our donation drive held from 1st to 31st August 2024 at our property sales galleries and group-managed properties, the library aims to enhance literacy among 112 children and youths in Kampung Paya Mendoi.
